



## NATURAL AREAS

**Mahler Park** (30 acres)  
244th Avenue SE and 436th  
Enumclaw, WA 98022

The city has plans to develop this site in the future. Currently, the park is undeveloped, but does offer trail access to Newaukum Creek. Future improvements will include interpretative area, trails, parking, picnic tables and a restroom facility, while keeping the park as a natural area.

**Fell Hill Park** (14 acres)  
Northeast of Enumclaw off SE 400th Street  
Enumclaw, WA 98022

This fourteen acre site was deeded to the City of Enumclaw as a donation. Currently, the park is undeveloped.

**Anderson Riverview Park** (20 acres)  
Mud Mountain Road  
Enumclaw, WA 98022

This community park is located on the White River, on SE Mud Mountain Road between 282nd Ave. SE and 260th Ave. SE. The park was donated to the city as a wilderness park in 1989. In the future, the city plans to open the park as a picnic, passive area. Currently, the park is undeveloped and not yet open for public use.
