**CALL TO ORDER:** The Park Board met in a regular session on November 12, 2025

Storton called the meeting to order 5:31 pm.

**BOARD COMMENTS:**

Gilthvedt asked if the Thunderdome that is currently up for sale could be a potential option for a Community Center. Hibbs stated that there has not been any official discussion about it.

Horn asked about the Rhododendron Garden property sale. Hibbs stated that the property sold as a private sale, there is some sort of agreement to maintain the garden as is.

McKinney stated that the reason that the Green River college is interested in the Anderson property is because there are about 500+ students looking to get into the Natural Resources

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program and that area is a great place for native planting.

Storton let the board know that he has accepted the council position, so December 31, 2025, will be his final Park Board meeting, he provided a letter of resignation.

McKinney spoke about how successful the Rotarian Club (7 different clubs; 1 from Pierce County) meeting was on Saturday; they planted approximately 250 plants, including edible plants.

Horn asked if the Archery Range Park has had any movement or updates. Hibbs responded that there have not been any changes but is on her list to focus on; she will make sure that this moves up in priority.

McKinney followed up on the trail that is located at the Golf Course; the limited Parks staff, has been trying to maintain the trail that was created. They plan to bring wood chips and material to make the trail accessible. Staff visit the trail 2-4 times per month to check on any transient activity at the trail.
