



TEMPORARY SIGNS - ROW - EXEMPT

Signs placed in the right-of-way are regulated as a temporary sign and are exempt from permitting when the following requirements are met.

Requirements for temporary signs in the right-of-way:

1. Location:

A. Temporary signs shall not be located in the right-of-way adjacent to public property owned or under the control of a unit of federal, state, or local government, or special purpose district such as a school, park, public utility, post, or library district, unless otherwise approved by the unit of government or special purpose district, or as conditioned in a right-of-way use permit.

B. Allowed only between the property line and the back of the nearest curb, or where no curb exists, between the property line and the nearest edge of the roadway pavement. Signs may not be placed on roundabouts, medians, shoulders, sidewalks, driveways or other paved areas designed for pedestrian or vehicular use, it cannot obstruct or interfere with traffic visibility, or the ability to clearly view governmental signs, it cannot be attached to a utility or governmental pole/post.

2. Approval of Abutting Owner. Approval of the abutting owner is required.

3. Type. Temporary signs on stakes that can be manually pushed or hammered into the ground are allowed.

4. Size and Height. Limited to 2 square feet and three feet in height.

5. Time Limits. Temporary signs shall be removed within 45 days after each year's November general election held immediately after installation.

6. Amount Limits. Maximum number of signs permitted is 5.
