



Dear New Customer,

The City of Enumclaw provides natural gas, water, sewer, storm water, and garbage services wherever available. Utility bills are prepared monthly based on monthly meter reads. The bills should be received the first few days of the month with a due date of the 28<sup>th</sup> of that month. If payment is not received within 5 days of the due date, a 1% or \$5 minimum late fee is charged to your account.

A Utility Shut-Off Notice will be mailed to all delinquent accounts 10 days after the due date of the 28<sup>th</sup> each month. Per Enumclaw Municipal Code, there is a \$20.00 service charge applied to the account at that time. This letter advises the customer of the date payment must be received before disconnection occurs. An additional \$25 Disconnect Fee is charged if payment is not received by the required date stated on the letter.

For your convenience, we have several payment options available:

- Pay in person at Finance Dept at City Hall or Night Drop Box in rear parking lot
  - Pay with VISA, Master Card or Discover Card;

The City also offers a Moving Monthly Payment Plan that helps budget your utility bill. To enroll please submit a completed application available at City Hall or on our website. Accounts must be current and in good standing to enroll in the plan.

To further assist our customers, a rate discount is available to Senior/Disabled Customers who meet the requirements for our Low-Income Senior or Disabled Utility Discount program. Information and application forms can be obtained at the Finance Department or online.

## **RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE, RECYCLING AND YARD WASTE INFORMATION**

### **➤ GARBAGE**

The City of Enumclaw offers residential garbage, recycling and yard waste removal within the City limits. Residential garbage services are designed to fit the needs of each customer, providing a choice of garbage service level as shown below:

- One 20 gallon can per week.....\$36.04/month
- One 32 gallon can per week.....\$39.93/month
- One 64 gallon can per week.....\$50.26/month
- One 96 gallon can per week.....\$60.61/month

Garbage is picked up on a weekly basis. Garbage cans should be placed at the curb by 6:00 am on your pick-up day. Please call City Shops within 24 hours if your trash was not picked up. Please contact the Utility Department to confirm your pick-up date. If you have more trash than your normal service, additional garbage can be left in a securely tied plastic bag or a 32 gallon can with a lid next to your garbage cart and your account will be charged \$5.83 per unit.

The City offers 1.5 yard temporary dumpsters to residents who have major clean-up projects. Dumpsters can be kept for a maximum of 30 days. Call the City Shops for more details and fee information for this service.

➤ **RECYCLING**

Curbside recycling services are provided to Enumclaw single family residents at no additional charge per paid garbage receptacle. Each additional recycling bin is available for \$14.69 per bin. Recyclable materials are collected every other week, opposite of yard waste, on your regular garbage pickup day. All recycling must be clean and fit into the blue 96-gallon recycling cart provided by the City. Cardboard is also accepted.

➤ **YARDWASTE**

Grass, leaves and prunings up to 2” in diameter are accepted in a 96-gallon wheeled cart provided by the City, for a charge of \$17.17 per month. Extra yard waste or prunings may be tied in bundles and placed next to your yard waste container. No rocks, concrete, sod, dirt, or pet waste is accepted. Collection of yard waste is provided every other week (opposite of recycling), on the same day as your garbage collection. Extra yard waste must be placed in a paper yardwaste bag, no plastic bags, and is limited to a 45-gallon bag with a maximum weight of 50 pounds and will be charged \$7.37 per unit.

- **A \$78.00 charge will apply to residents who stop and restart Solid waste service within a 12-month period.**
- **A Cart-exchange fee of \$36.40 will apply to residents who exchange their solid waste cart size more than once within a 12-month period.**
- **Tampering Charge. Account holders shall be charged a tampering charge of \$60.64 as set forth in the fee resolution for removal of baffles installed in 35-gallon carts which are installed to establish the capacity of the cart at the lower capacity of 20 gallons. Removal of the baffle will result in upgrading the account to a 32-gallon service and the cart will be replaced with the appropriate cart container.**
