The Plumbing System shall comply with the current UPC as amended by the State of Washington and to the Seismic Restraint Manual by SMACNA. Note: All bathtubs, whirlpools showers, accessible & public lavatories without a single handle mixing valve shall have a mixing valve at the bathtub, whirlpool, shower, lavatory, or at the hot water heater per current UPC. The Mechanical System shall comply with the current IMC as amended by the State of Washington and to the Seismic Restraint Manual by SMACNA.

- Homes on septic systems require King County Health Department approval before any addition can be added to the home.
- An expansion tank is required on all new water heater installations and dielectric insulators at all water heater connections.
- All water systems shall have water hammer arrestors and shall be accessible section 609.10. UPC.
- All bathtubs, whirlpools, showers, accessible and public lavatories without a single handle mixing valve shall have a mixing valve at the bathtub, whirlpool, shower, lavatory, or at the hot water heater per the current UPC sections 409 through 417.
- For all new and changed out heating and cooling units you shall submit calculations as stated in the Washington State Energy Code section 503.2.2 to the City's Building Department.
