Project Description: Replacement of two parallel corrugated metal pipe (CMP) culverts with one, 6-foot high by 10-foot wide concrete box culvert under Battersby Avenue. Emergency repairs were made to the culverts with a HDPE pipe sleeve in 2009. The project is designed to maintain the road, provide a pathway for the future Foothills-Battersby Trail Project, and improve fish passage and habitat. Project scope includes installation of diversion dams and culvert channel restoration and stabilization.

Project Location: Drainage District 5 Lateral 'B' ditch crossing at Battersby Avenue, nearest address is 27602 SE 440th Street, Enumclaw, WA, within a portion of Section 24, Township 20 North, Range 6 East, and Section 19, Township 20 North, Range 7 East.

Determination of Non-Significance: The lead agency for this proposal has determined that the requirements for environmental analysis, protection, and mitigation measures have been adequately addressed in the development regulations and comprehensive plan adopted under Chapter 36.70A, RCW, and in in other applicable local, state, or federal laws or rules, as provided by RCW 43.21C.240 and WAC 197-11-158. Our agency will not require any additional mitigation measures under SEPA. The project as proposed, does not have a probable significant adverse impact.
