## **SUBMISSION**

All two-dimensional work must be suitably framed and ready for hanging. Hooks and wire only, no sawtooth hangers will be accepted. Artwork is not to exceed 12" x 12" including frame. Initial representation of the work should be made by e-mail.

Entry forms must be received by **June 25, 2021**.

All artwork based on photo references must be original to the artist submitting the art. Artwork must be dry, finished, and ready to display with wire attached. No exposed glass edges, uni-frames, clip frames, frames in disrepair, or sawtooth hangers, exposed staples or unfinished edges will be accepted.

## **SALES**

All work submitted must be for sale. Sales will be the responsibility of the artist and the interested patron. No commission is to be collected.

## **NOTIFICATION OF ACCEPTED WORKS**

Notification of acceptance will be made no later than **July 2, 2021**.

## **DELIVERY OF ACCEPTED WORKS**

Accepted work must be hand-delivered to Les Schwab Hall at Enumclaw Expo Center, 45224 284th Ave SE, Enumclaw, WA 98022 on July 12 between 2-5 PM.

Labels will be created for each piece so please fill out all information regarding your pieces on the following page. Upon completion of the exhibition, work must also be picked-up in person at 6 PM Sunday July 18th or Monday July 19th between 9 am –12 pm at Les Schwab Hall at the Enumclaw Expo Center.
