**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENUMCLAW,
KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON ADOPTING THE 2022-2027 SIX-YEAR
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.**

Whereas, the Public Works Department is responsible for the construction, maintenance and operation of city streets, and

Whereas, the Public Works Department has prepared an updated Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the period of 2022 through 2027, and

Whereas, RCW 35.77.010 requires the Six-Year TIP to be consistent with the City's comprehensive plan, annually revised to reflect completed projects and extended in time, and

Whereas, the proposed Six-Year TIP has been amended to include current and anticipated revenues that could be used for funding the recommended projects, and

Whereas, the City Council held a public hearing in the Enumclaw City Hall Council Chambers on May 24, 2021 at or about 7:00 p.m. to receive comments on the proposed Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program.

Now, therefore, the City Council of the City of Enumclaw, King County, Washington do hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1: That the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for 2022-2027 as submitted to the City Council and attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated by reference, is hereby adopted.

Section 2: That a copy of this resolution and the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for 2022 through 2027 is to be filed by the City Clerk with the Washington State Department of Transportation.


