- LAWN CLIPPINGS, PRUNING, FOOD-SOILED PAPER AND FOOD SCRAPS
- EACH TOTE SHOULD HAVE A LABEL LISTING ACCEPTABLE ITEMS. IF YOURS DOES NOT, PLEASE LET US KNOW!
- A COMPLETE LIST OF ACCEPTABLE/UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS ARE AVAILABLE BY CALLING 360-825-5541 OR ONLINE AT: CITYOFENUMCLAW.NET
- WEIGHT LIMIT: 250 #
- **NO** ROCKS, SOD, DIRT OR PET WASTE
- ALL YARDWASTE MUST FIT INSIDE THE TOTE, WITH THE **LID CLOSED**.
- BRANCHES CANNOT EXCEED 4' IN LENGTH OR 4" IN DIAMETER
- YARDWASTE IS PICKED UP EVERY OTHER WEEK, OPPOSITE OF RECYCLING ON YOUR REGULAR GARBAGE PICK-UP DAY
- **CARTS THAT ARE REMOVED & REDELIVERED WITHIN 12 MONTHS, WILL BE ACCESSED A DELIVERY CHARGE OF \$28.09.**
- **EXTRA BAG 45GAL PAPERBAG/CAN \$5.94EA**

Container Placement

Please place your recycling, garbage and yardwaste containers at the curb/street/alley by 6:00 AM on your scheduled pickup day...

- at least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes and fences
- as close to the curb as possible
- cart lids opening toward the street w/lid closed.
- two (2) feet apart from other receptacles

REMOVE CONTAINERS FROM THE STREET AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AFTER COLLECTION

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES:

- USE ONLY TOTES PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF ENUMCLAW
- **ALL TRASH MUST FIT IN THE TOTE WITH THE LID CLOSED**
- **NO** YARDWASTE IS ACCEPTED IN GARBAGE TOTE
- PLEASE HAVE ALL TRASH IN TIED BAGS
- IF YOU WISH TO INCREASE OR DECREASE YOUR TOTE SIZE, CONTACT US AT 360-825-5541.

CITY-WIDE CLEAN UP

EACH FALL, THE CITY CONDUCTS A CITY-WIDE CLEAN UP. ALL SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE CUSTOMERS ARE ALLOWED ONE APPLIANCE AND/OR AN ADDITIONAL 1-5 BAGS OF TRASH FOR COLLECTION. DATES VARY FROM YEAR TO YEAR, SO CONTACT US IN EARLY SEPTEMBER FOR DATES

ANNUAL RECYCLING COLLECTION EVENT

IN COLLABORATION WITH KING COUNTY, A RECYCLING COLLECTION EVENT IS AVAILABLE IN LATE SPRING. CHECK ONLINE FOR INFORMATION IN EARLY SPRING.

- #1 PET/PETE - Plastic Bottles (water, sports drink, salad dressing) plastic peanut butter and jelly jars.
- #2 HDPE - Bottles/jugs (milk, juice, detergent and shampoo bottles, etc.)
- #5 Plastic - Dairy Tubs, e.g. butter, yogurt, cottage cheese

Paper

- Newspaper including adds and inserts
- Corrugated Cardboard Boxes
- Direct Mail
- Cereal, cracker, tissue, Kraft & shoe boxes
- Office paper-copier & printer paper, file folders, note paper, computer paper, brochures
- Magazines & Catalogs
- Paper Towel & Toilet Paper Tubes

Glass

- Food or beverage containers

Metal

- Tin, aluminum & steel food or beverage containers

Plastic

#3, #4, #6 & #7 plastics, plastic bags, plastic cups, plastic film; plastic bottles that contained HHW listed materials; deli, bakery and produce clamshell containers; loose lids - any size; plant trays; PVC; large rigid plastic (outdoor furniture, laundry baskets, swimming pools, toys, etc.) hoses; landscaping/sprinkler tubing

Paper

Shredded paper; paper envelopes with bubble wrap liners, insulation liners or envelopes made from plastic; laminated paper, stickers, labels, photos, carbon paper, receipts, paper affixed to magnets; wax or aseptic containers; pet food bags; mixed material bags; wet or soiled paper; paper with large amounts of paint or glue

Cardboard

Waxed cardboard, wet cardboard

Glass

Leaded glass: windows, mirrors, baking dishes, storage dishes, ceramic, plates, glassware, storage/canning jars

Metal

Aluminum foil and trays; sharp or greasy metal; batteries; propane tanks, microwaves; electrical cords; cell phones; car snow chains. Empty aerosol cans, metal appliances

Misc

Trash, Food Waste, Yardwaste, needles/syringes, motor oil or auto fluids
