ENUMCLAW'S PROPOSED VISION STATEMENT

Written with community members, April 25, 2023; reviewed by Planning Commission

Enumclaw brings people together with a sense of community that values all ages and incomes. Our vision is to grow with the intention to provide services and institutions for the well-being of our residents and businesses. We plan to provide diverse housing choices so that young people will return, and older residents can afford to remain.

Enumclaw treasures its agricultural heritage and historic downtown. We imagine a streetscape, vibrant with public art, that accommodates all types of transportation including pedestrians which will connect residents to services, schools, the downtown, and city and regional recreation facilities. To raise families and to do business, the community must keep safety a priority.

MAJOR THEMES FROM THE VISION

- Grow with Intention
- Provide adequate services
- Seek housing choices for young families
- Seek housing choices so older people can stay
- Treasure our historic downtown
- Revive the downtown streetscape
- Sustain the value of local enterprise and businesses
- Connect downtown to other places in town
- Keep Enumclaw a safe place

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PROCESS

- Assess existing conditions in Enumclaw. How well is Enumclaw being served by things like parks, water, sewer, public buildings and services (fire, police, library, etc.), traffic, sidewalks, bike paths?
- Take a look at forecast growth. How will Enumclaw accommodate new housing and jobs?
- Map out lands for residential, commercial, and open spaces.
- Create growth strategies, goals, and policies to accommodate the Community's Vision.
- Adopt a new Comprehensive Plan by December, 2024.
