

Mobile Home Permits



What Manufactured/Mobile Home Permits does the City of Enumclaw review and issue?

The City of Enumclaw reviews and issues all Mobile Home Setting permits and any other structure that is **NOT ATTACHED** to the manufactured/mobile home.

Examples include:

- Mobile Home Setting
- Replacement Mobile Home Setting
- Demolition of Mobile Home
- Detached carport/garage
- Detached porch (not anchored to the manufactured/mobile home)
- Detached porch stairs (not anchored to the manufactured/mobile home)
- Detached shed/accessory structure
- Gas Generator

Processing time to receive your permit:

4-6 weeks once applications are deemed complete by intake staff

What Manufactured/Mobile Home Permits does Labor & Industries review and issue?

Labor & Industries processes all alterations that are **ATTACHED/INSIDE** the house, including but not limited to all plumbing, mechanical, and roofing.

Examples include:

Appliances

Air conditioners/heat pumps.
Clothes washer.
Clothes dryer (electric).
Clothes dryer (gas).
Dishwasher.
Microwave (over range).
Range/Oven alterations.

Structural changes

Doors (interior or exterior).
Earthquake-resistant bracing structure.
Interior alterations.
Painting & siding.
Roofing.
Structural Changes/Interior remodeling.
Windows.

Water, electric, gas, plumbing

(inside the home)
Electrical.
Furnace alterations (electric or gas).
Gas lines.
Plumbing.
Water heater (electric).
Water heater (gas).

Pellet or wood stove, fireplace

Pellet stove.
Wood stove, or fireplace.

Processing time to receive your permit:

- Online: Immediately
- In person at a service location: Temporarily unavailable
- Postal mail: 2-3 business days for processing + mailing time

All other alteration applications, allow 2-3 weeks for a response. Accuracy and completeness speeds up the processing time.
